- Your child can register online and use all of the online resources which include prizes, special videos and resources, book recommendations, and much more. If you do NOT have access to the internet or do not want to track your child's reading online contact one of the teachers above.
- Your child is expected to read 60 minutes per week minimum from June 8 – August 14. This will be a total of 600 minutes minimum for the whole summer. Your child may read and record ANYTHING that helps them enjoy summer reading including books, magazine articles, newspaper, online articles, etc.. We want your child to authentically read for enjoyment throughout the summer.
- When your child starts 5th Grade in the fall they will need to turn in the following items for us to celebrate their reading:
  - o 600 minutes of hours logged online or on paper and signed by parent/guardian
  - o Top 5 students in number of minutes will receive a special award/recognition
